TO: AUTOMATIC DELIVERY CUSTOMERS

As an AUTOMATIC DELIVERY customer, Baygas will keep your tank filled without worry; however, due to extra heavy use, new appliances, pool heater, or anything out of the ordinary, if you run out of gas and it is not within your scheduled delivery time period, there will be a truck fee.

YOU must call Baygas for the FIRST FOUR fill ups. This will help determine how often you will need gas.

The Automatic Delivery plan authorizes you to charge the gas we deliver to your tank. But, we will not deliver any gas if you have a current balance due.* Any account that is over 30 days past due will be dropped from the Automatic Delivery list.

If you move or decide to drop the Automatic Delivery Plan, YOU must notify Baygas of your intentions. If you do not and we deliver gas to the tank at that address, you will be responsible for payment. Sorry, but we do not know if and when you move, unless you inform us. Once we have been informed we will send you a release to sign for our files.

Please make a habit of checking your propane tank monthly and weekly during harsh weather. If the gauge on your tank reads 40% or less CALL BAYGAS!

AUTOMATIC DELIVERY CUSTOMERS

Please make a habit of checking your percentage (%) gauge on your tank at least once a month or more during the cold weather. If your tank gauge reads 30% to 40%, call Baygas at 281-332-2630 and let us know.

Please let us know if you have any changes in your propane usage, i.e. added a gas dryer, new spa, and/or someone home now every day. We will adjust your usage in our computer software to help prevent interruption of service prior to your next scheduled delivery.

Your tank must be kept accessible for us to keep it filled. If you build a fence around the tank, we must have a gate or entrance leading directly to the tank. In case of an emergency the driver has to quickly reach the truck. Remember if you lock the gate, we must have a key. The fence and/or shrubs must be at least 3 feet from the sides of the tank. Do not block the drive and path with cars, RV's, building materials, or landscaping. Our trucks only have so many feet of hose. With driveway or path blockage, we may not be able to reach your tank. The delivery man will not pull the hose over anything that might damage or tear it.
